 - How does this topic relate to other issues we have discussed in class?
 2. If your chosen lecture is from the 'Inspirations for Actions' section of the course then answer these questions as a minimum:
 - What is your personal opinion regarding this approach for potential solutions?
 - How does this approach relate to other issues we have discussed in class?

Feel free to bring up other issues you think are interesting to discuss

Include proper references of all sources. A minimum of two references from the assigned literature for the week that you have chosen to write about, and an additional two references from other course literature (i.e. Course Reader from other weeks or Course Books) must be included.

Send in one document including: your name, date and name of the course. Submit your document, titled: Surname.Givename_Attendance, on the specific Hand-in section on **Studentportalen**. The deadline to submit this assignment is on **December 20th**.

Please note that this deadline is important since final grades/results for the course will be handed over to the administration on December 21st.
