Therefore, we ask you to read another group's project essay (sent to you through email by Course Coordinators) and answer the questions below.

1. Summarize very briefly the basic characteristics of the group's vision of 2056 and their backcasting plan. (Approximately 300 words)
2. What questions do you have to this group? List 3 questions concerning their paper. Elaborate and explain your question if needed.
3. What did you 'like' about their project (e.g. agree, inspired, impressed with, etc.)? In addition, what would you critique?
Explain and elaborate your points in approximately 400 words.

Name your file as "Surname.GivennameMUT-Presentation", and upload on **Studentportalen** in the specific Hand-In area by **December 16th**.
