Attendance and active participation during the sessions named “Seminars” and “Workshops” are mandatory and part of the overall examination of the course. Therefore, this make-up task must be completed in order to meet all the requirements to pass the course.

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For those that were absent, the following extra task must be completed by **October 22<sup>nd</sup>** and submitted through **Studentportalen** in the specific Hand-In area.

Seminar 1 included, among other things:

1. Presentation of the creative outcomes and reflections for the 30DC
2. “Start – Stop – Continue” for the course GCSF 2015
3. Introduction to the Final Group Project: Group Formation

**1. The 30DC has been an activity to encourage individual action on a sustainability issue, to experiment how does it feel to challenge yourself and to contribute, with your behaviour, to a more sustainable World, but how does that relate to other individuals? and with other actors (institutions, companies, governments)?**

Discuss about the roles of individuals and other actors, such as institutions, governments, companies, other individuals, associations, etc. to achieve a more sustainable future. What do you think is more relevant to achieve change? How are the interconnections among those actors?

Discuss in approximately **400 words**, including at least **2 references** from the course literature.

**2. Write a short reflection about the course including, at least, one thing you would like to START, one think you would like to CONTINUE and something you would like to STOP, and explain why.**

During Seminar 1, we discussed about what do you like about the course (Continue), what are you missing (Start) and what would you stop doing (Stop), and we would like to know what are your reflections and thoughts to improve the course.

You can use the following [link](#) to a Google Form if you want to be anonymous. In this case, send us a *screenshot* of the message that appear once you send the form.

Discuss in approximately **400 words**.

**3. In the course website you will find the instructions for the first part of the Group Project: “Back from the Future We Want: Visions”. Read the instructions and choose a group.**
