

Make-Up Task | Seminar 1

Seminar 1 included, among other things:

1. A presentation and group discussion our work for Assignment 1 Spaceship Earth
2. A literature discussion based on the preparation already done before class (see 'Seminar 1: Literature Review Preparations' on the CEMUS course portal)

For those who missed Seminar 1, the following extra task is given in two parts, which must be completed by the latest **Friday, 26th February**.

1. After the lecture next week, **February 24th - Participatory Design (room 12:004)**, you will meet with the group of people who couldn't make it during Seminar 1 to present your work for Assignment 1. Bring your original work and you will have around 5 minutes to present your design + open questions from us and/or the other participants (around 30 minutes maximum for the discussion).
2. Write a literature discussion paper of around 1,5 - 2 pages (approximately 800 words) which covers the article you chose for the literature review (see 'Seminar 1: Literature Review Preparations').

Consider and answer the following points in your paper:

- a) Explain what would be the three main ideas of the article.
- b) What would a designer takeaway from the article you have been reading? Explain why, from your point of view, those are interesting points for a designer.
- c) Imagine that you were given this article in your program and/or previous studies. Would it be perceived as relevant for the whole class or a waste of time or...? Why? Explain what would be the main reactions and why.

You may include other course literature in your discussion if you wish. This is an open discussion of your thoughts and opinions around course literature and is not meant as a formal academic paper, but if you include quotes or refer directly to sources, include a reference.

Submit your file in a Word or PDF to the Studentportalen in the 'Submit Make Up Task' section, under 'Seminar I' at the latest **12:00 on Friday, 26th February**. Include your surname and 'MUT_S1' in the name of the file, f.ex.: Marcos_MUT_S1.
