- 2** Select a section of the text (a paragraph, or two) that you find particularly crucial to the authors' argument, and/or struck you as a particularly eye-opening point.
- 3** Write a short text explaining why you consider this specific part of the article worth sharing.
- 4** You will, in class, discuss this text with a group of other classmates who have read the same article, and then work on a problem (which will be given in the seminar) together.

Submit your selected text from the article, either as a typed text, or as a readable photo of clearly marked the text, along with your the explanation in a Word or PDF to the Studentportalen <https://studentportalen.uu.se> in the 'Submit Preparation Task' section, under 'Seminar I - Literature Review Preparations' at the latest **12:00 on Wednesday, 10th February**, and bring a copy to Seminar I. Include your surname and the surname of the first author in the name of the file, f.ex.: Marcos_Margolin.doc or Anderson_Chick.pdf.
