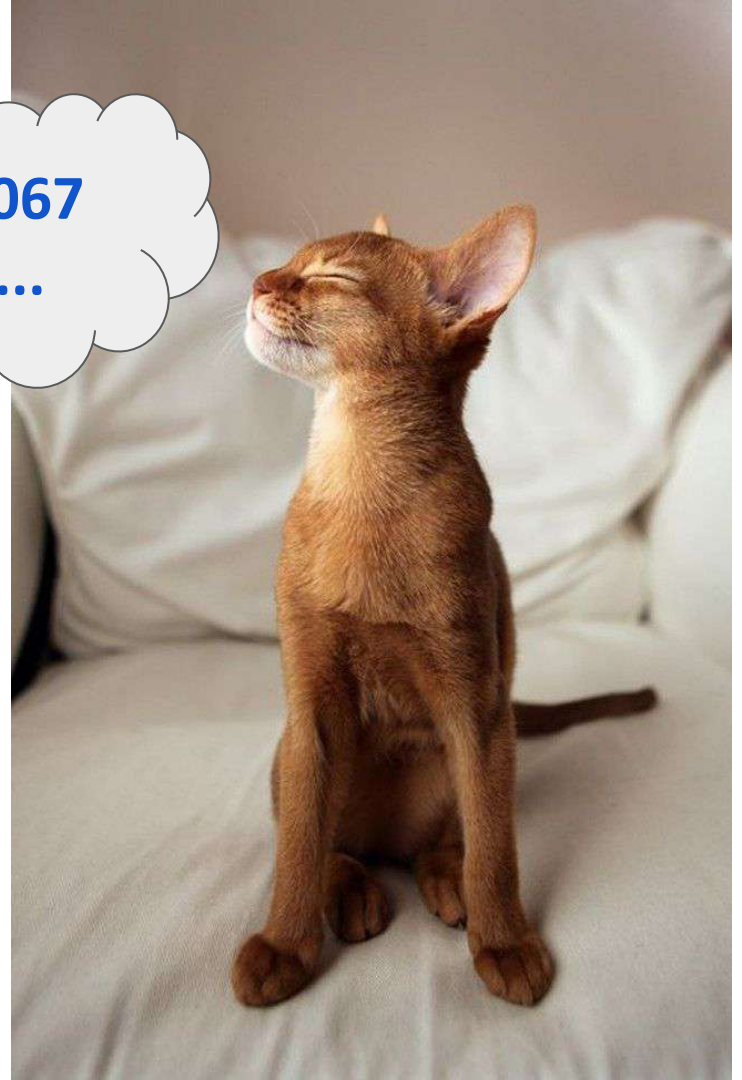

Develop **Four** Sustainable Visions for 2067

...in three steps

Step 1) Choose 2 Parametres out of these and make an axis

- High socio-economic equality - High socio-economic inequality
- High tech - Low tech
- Culturally diverse - Culturally homogenous
- High biodiversity - Low biodiversity
- High migration - Low migration
- Democratic (Participatory) - Authoritarian (Elitist)
- High economic growth - Low economic growth
- High consumption - Low consumption
- Green space high (high nature contact) - low (nature contact)
- Globalization - Regionalization

Uppsala, like Sweden, is not in the EU and very high tech

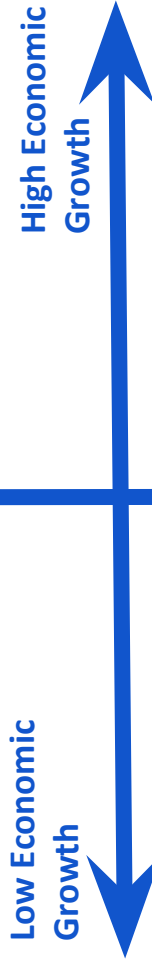
Diverse English-speaking Uppsala growing in height

Low Migration

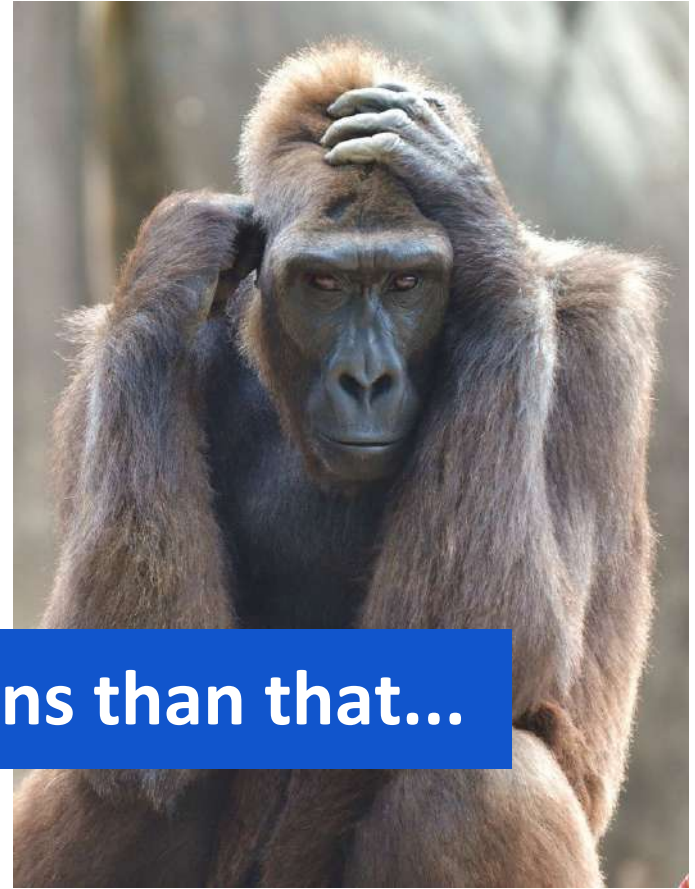
Uppsala's population decreases a lot

High Migration

Uppsala as a safe haven, but one with increasing social tensions

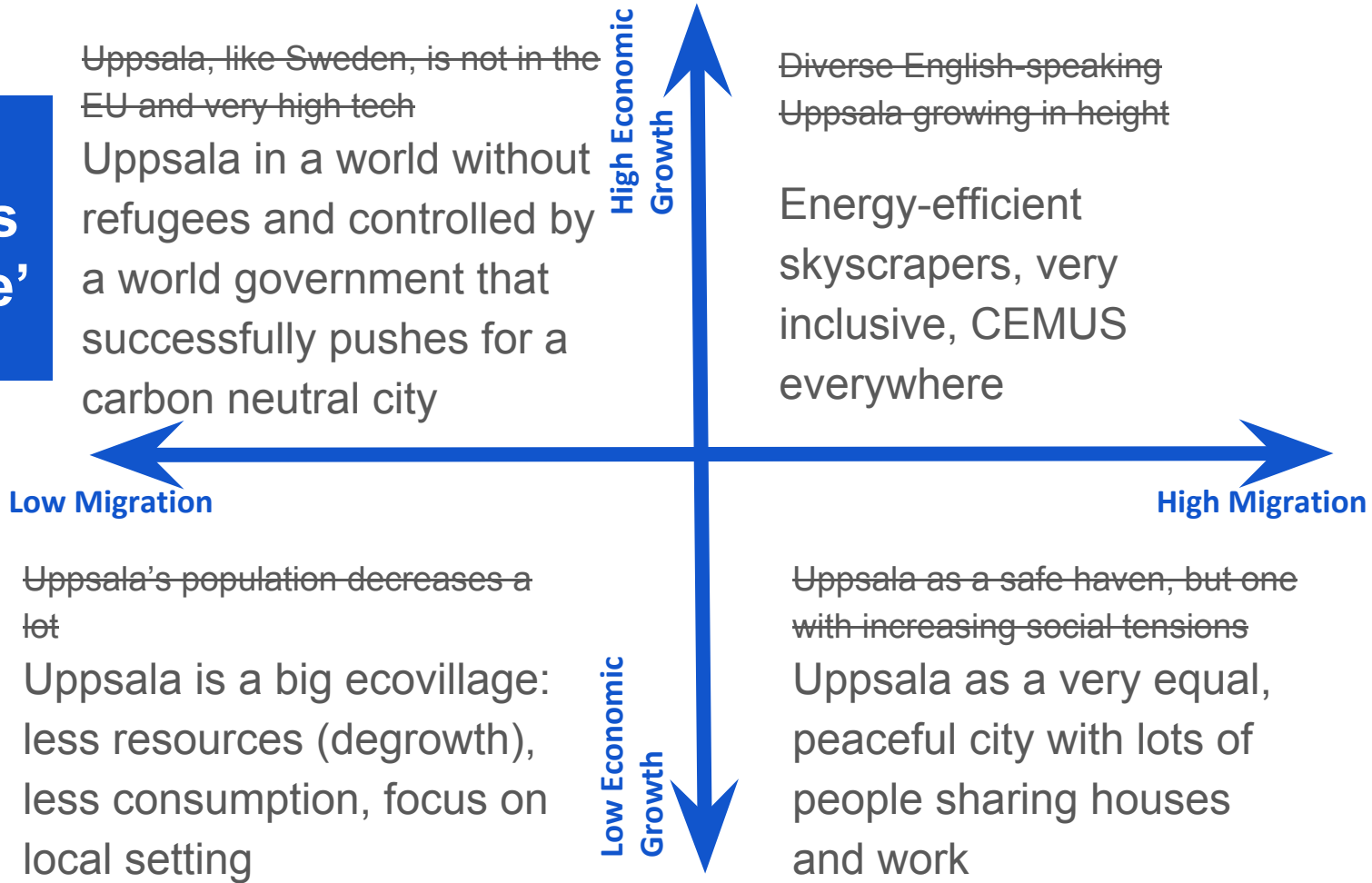


But we want more complex visions than that...

What if cities in 2067 were designed for children?

~~Uppsala in a world without refugees and controlled by a world government that successfully pushes for a carbon neutral city~~
World government pushes for cities to have playgrounds and games everywhere

~~Uppsala is a big ecovillage: less resources (degrowth), less consumption, focus on local setting~~
Ecovillage revolving around local connections with children

~~Energy-efficient skyscrapers, very inclusive, CEMUS everywhere~~
Soft, colourful, energy-efficient skyscrapers, University mainly for children

~~Uppsala as a very equal, peaceful city with lots of people sharing houses and work~~
Peaceful Uppsala with children as decision-makers: Children are anywhere anytime

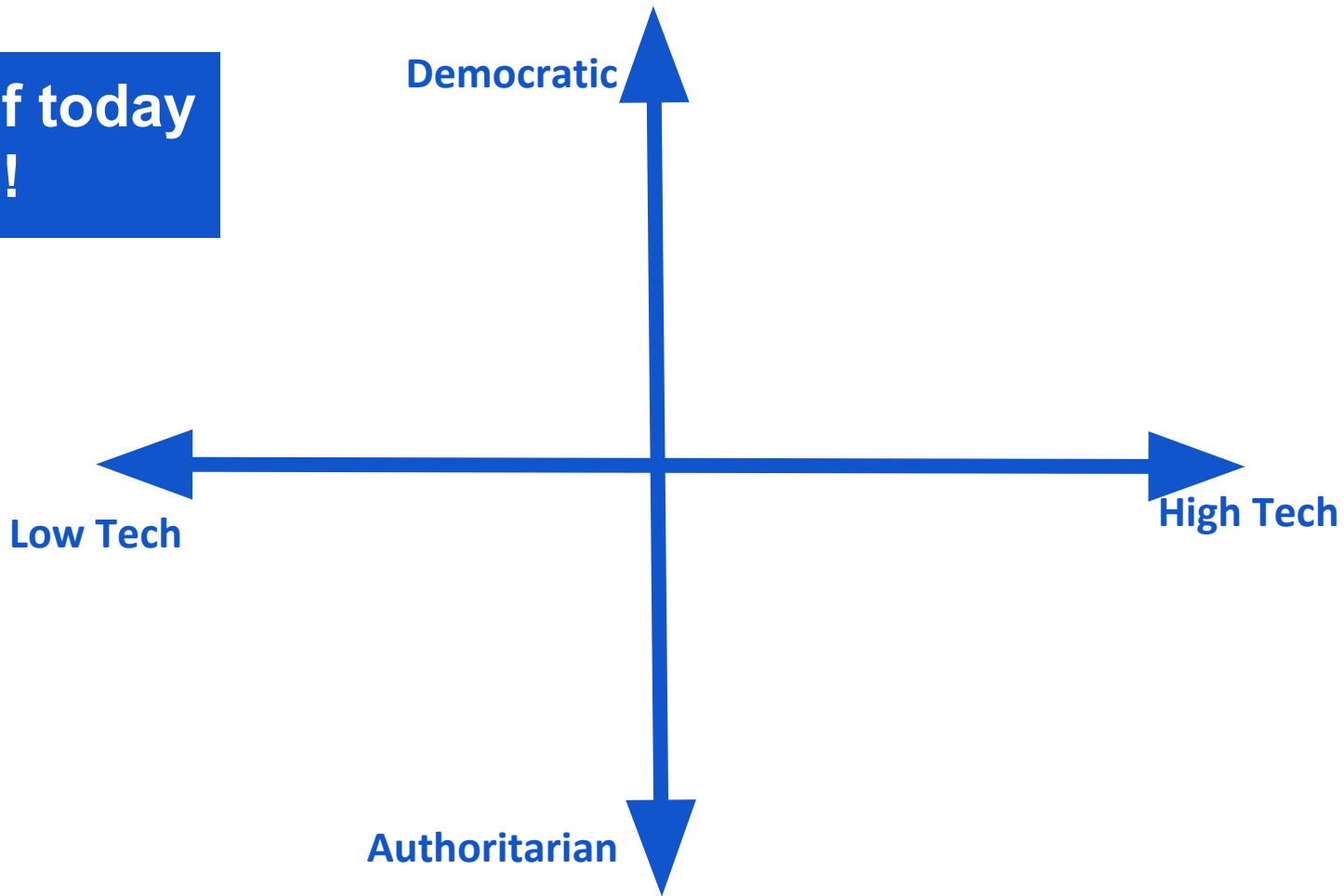
