At WinterFest17, students and actors connected to CEMUS will be exhibiting and sharing how they are working with sustainability. There will be short presentations, exhibitions of artwork, and films during the day, and live music and performance during the evening. Our course, Global Challenge & Sustainable Futures, will be a part of the festival in two ways, but of course, you are welcome to participate in the rest of the festival program for the whole day! The program is being released online this week - so stay tuned! In the evening, there will be three live bands playing and a poetry performance, so it can be like an afterparty / semester wrap up hang out for all of CEMUS!

1) Map of the World 2067: Sustainable and desirable futures around the world

We have discussed the role and power of utopias in Tim Parrique's lecture on October 17th and during other parts of this class. Can utopias be a force for political imagination? (Miguel Abensour) Should we move from negative stories to positive stories about sustainability? Or should we start the conversation about society more critically? As part of wrapping up this project, we would like to share your visions with people outside of class. That way, we as a class can start a conversation with others about the future and what we should do now. To do this, we are going to co-create a world map of sustainable and desirable 2067 visions, based on your work in the project. The map will be a self-explored exhibition piece at the WinterFest17 in Uppsala on Thursday, December 14th.

We will have a link where the content cannot be edited later). Drop a pin to the region you selected, and add the text and image. On the title, you can add a title for your vision and add your name. (E.g. Child-friendly Ecovillage by John Smith.) After the Festival, we would like to share this online, so if you would like to be anonymous or have a fake/pen-name, feel free to do so, and just let us know. 2) 30 Day Challenge exhibition

We would like you to exhibit the creative outcome of your 30 Day Challenge during the festival, as you did during our Workshop on October 17th:

- **Come to Kollaboratoriet at 11am to set up your Creative Outcome exhibition**
If you can't come at the time, ask another classmate to set it up for you. If there are any other concerns, come talk to us directly. The idea is that your contribution can be standing there as part of the exhibition. If you feel like your contribution is not self-explanatory, please make a short explanation card to add to your creative outcome. If you need something printed out, please email us by latest Tuesday, December 12th 14.00. Please make it PDF format and specify color/grayscale and the print size.
- **Talk to the festival participants about your experience during the mingle Lucia fika at 15.00-15.30 at Kollaboratoriet**
We have put in the program that students from our class will be standing by their Creative Outcome during this fika. We will have a mark/name tag for you to show that you are part of our class. Share your experience with other festival participants!
- If possible, **leave your creative outcome at Kollaboratoriet and come back at 18 to take down your Creative Outcome from the exhibition.**
