Active Participation and Written Preparation (3 credits)

Active Participation (pass/fail):

Through a series of tasks, both written and oral, you will be able to show that you are actively participating in the course and are reading and reflecting on the literature.

- **Regular Sessions:** minimum attendance requirement of 75% overall, including participating in active discussion with guests
- **Mandatory Sessions:** (marked blue in the schedule): compulsory attendance 100%
- **Weekly missions:** 75% overall contribution to two different preparatory Padlets
- **Reading Circle:** bi-weekly hand ins (**February 4th and 18th, March 4th and 18th**)
