- Who are you? Tell us about yourself and your background.
- What are your intellectual and academic interests at the moment?
- Are you involved in any activities/initiatives that have a connection to climate change issues?
- Why do you want to go to the intersessional meeting in Bonn?
- How does participating in this event fit in with your professional interests and trajectory in life?

Please also include the following information in your application: complete name, date of birth, Swedish permanent or temporary personal number, nationality, passport number and country of issue, dates which you are able to attend the conference, email address.
