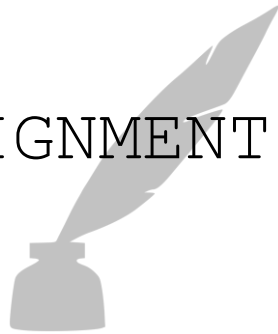


ASSIGNMENT 1 – WHY CHANGE?

Assignment Overview

In preparation for this first mandatory seminar “Opportunities for Change” of this course, we want to quickly hear about your thoughts on change. Some questions to consider are:
